## ADAARAN SELECT MEEDHUPPARU: INTEGRATING CONTEMPORARY HOSPITALITY AND SUSTAINABILITY



ADAARAN SELECT MEEDHUPPARU IS RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF THE TOP 100 SUSTAINABLE HOTELS & RESORTS OF THE WORLD 2025 BY THE LUXURY LIFESTYLE AWARDS. SPANNING A VERDANT MALDIVIAN ISLAND, THE RESORT COMBINES A PREMIUM ALL-INCLUSIVE HOSPITALITY MODEL WITH ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP, OFFERING GUESTS AN IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE THAT BALANCES LEISURE WITH A STRONG CONNECTION TO NATURE.

### Thoughtful Design and Guest Experience

The resort is designed to harmonize with its surroundings, featuring one of the Maldives' best house reefs. Guests are invited to explore vibrant coral gardens or simply unwind under the shade of towering banyan trees on this mature island. Every aspect of the property emphasizes a low-impact, eco-conscious approach while maintaining comfort and sophistication.

### Sustainability in Practice

Adaaran Select Meedhupparu has implemented measurable environmental initiatives, demonstrating leadership in sustainable operations. Water intensity per guest night has decreased by 6.8% through demand-based pressure control and continuous monitoring, while energy intensity has been reduced by 2.12% via inverter AC systems, LED retrofits, motion-sensor lighting, and solar walkway illumination. Organic waste is converted into 32,719 kg of soil enhancers, and nearly 395,000 single-use plastic bottles have been replaced with in-house glass alternatives. Local sourcing is prioritized, including over 40,000 kg of fish and 83,000 kg of fruits and vegetables, complemented by on-island food production of vegetables and coconuts.

### Biodiversity and Education

A core differentiator is the resort's "Painting the Canvas of Conservation" initiative. Launched in January 2025, this program translates on-island



biodiversity surveys into the interactive picture and activity book, The Colors of Our Islands. Guests, students, and staff engage with local species profiles, conservation pledges, and reef-safe practices, promoting eco-literacy and behavior change. Through this initiative, sustainability becomes both educational and tangible, reinforcing the resort's holistic environmental strategy.

### Certifications and Governance

Operations align with global standards, including Green Globe Standard 1.7, HACCP, ISO 22000:2018, and the UNWTO Responsible Tourism Code of Ethics. Continuous training and sustainability education programs ensure that associates and guests are active participants in conservation, reinforcing the resort's position as a model of responsible tourism.

### Strategic Vision for Sustainable Hospitality

The resort's sustainability framework is guided by a comprehensive management plan that sets measurable goals for water, energy, waste, and biodiversity. Leadership at the corporate and property levels coordinates innovative green technologies and operational practices, addressing challenges such as limited renewable energy options in the Maldives and high investment costs. Future initiatives aim to expand these sustainability measures and explore new approaches to environmentally conscious hospitality.

## WHERE SUSTAINABILITY MEETS SOPHISTICATION: CROWNE PLAZA CHANGI AIRPORT



CROWNE PLAZA CHANGI AIRPORT, RECENTLY RECOGNISED AMONG THE TOP 100 SUSTAINABLE HOTELS & RESORTS OF THE WORLD, CONTINUES TO SHAPE A MORE RESPONSIBLE FUTURE FOR MODERN HOSPITALITY. HONORED BY THE INTERNATIONAL SUSTAINABILITY AWARDS, THE PROPERTY HAS EMERGED AS AN INDUSTRY BENCHMARK FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRESS WHILE DELIVERING A SOPHISTICATED AIRPORT-SIDE EXPERIENCE UNMATCHED IN CONVENIENCE AND CONTEMPORARY STYLE. AS CROWNE PLAZA CHANGI AIRPORT ADVANCES ITS SUSTAINABILITY GOALS, IT REMAINS A FAVORITE AMONG GLOBAL TRAVELLERS SEEKING COMFORT, EFFICIENCY, AND THOUGHTFUL INNOVATION.

### A Sustainability Strategy with Measurable Impact

Crowne Plaza Changi Airport's green philosophy is anchored in the IHG Journey to Tomorrow initiative, which guides all IHG properties in building a responsible hospitality ecosystem. The hotel's achievement of the IHG Green Engage Level 4 certification highlights its advanced approach, driven by its Environmental Management Committee. Every aspect of its operation reflects a deep-seated drive to reduce waste, energy output, and water use.

A standout initiative is the installation of in-room filtered drinking water systems, replacing traditional plastic water bottles. In a high-turnover environment like Changi Airport, this shift dramatically cuts single-use plastic consumption, supporting a projected annual reduction of more than half a million bottles. Complementing this, the hotel has expanded plastic-reducing efforts with bulk-size bathroom amenities, refillable glass bottles in meeting rooms, and biodegradable straws.



The hotel was also an early adopter of the food digester, transforming food waste into greywater. As Norway's first hotel to receive the Nordic Swan Ecolabel back in 2002, Radisson Blu Plaza Hotel Oslo has long been a frontrunner in responsible hospitality. The hotel's continued Green Key certification since 2015 reinforces its active participation in the country's eco-evolution. Every initiative, from reducing waste to rethinking energy consumption, reflects a methodical and measurable approach to sustainability.

In a significant step forward, the hotel introduced Norway's first Voluntary Climate Contribution program, adding NOK 30 to each guest's room bill to directly fund verified green projects. This innovative model exemplifies how a collective contribution can drive large-scale change, allowing guests to participate in tangible sustainability outcomes.

### Technology That Transforms Impact

One of the hotel's most notable achievements is the use of artificial intelligence to reduce food waste. Partnering with the intelligent WINNOW system, the hotel cut food waste by an impressive 67% between 2023 and 2024, equating to just 230 grams per guest, well below the European average of 340 grams.

This technological leap doesn't just save resources; it provides valuable data that continually refines operations. The approach has inspired new sustainability discussions across Norway's hospitality industry, showing how technology can drive both environmental and economic efficiency.



### Green Energy and Measurable Progress

Sourcing 100% of its electricity from hydropower, the hotel operates with zero CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from energy use. Its consumption per guest night, 33.3 kWh in 2024, compared to the European average of 45.2 kWh, demonstrates how careful monitoring and responsible management can lead to significant environmental gains.

Further initiatives include replacing 90% of all lighting with LED systems, installing over 80 EV chargers in its parking garage, and hosting 100% carbon-neutral meetings through verified carbon credit purchases from partners such as Agreena. Each step contributes to the hotel's broader goal: achieving a 50% emission reduction by 2030 and full carbon neutrality by 2050.

The results speak volumes. Between 2023 and 2024, total CO<sub>2</sub>e emissions per guest night fell by 15%, reaching 8.87 kg. This measurable success underscores the hotel's pragmatic and data-driven sustainability philosophy.

### Water, Waste, and the Human Factor

The hotel's environmental progress extends far beyond technology. By introducing reusable water carafes in guest rooms, it saves around 110,000 plastic bottles every year. The upcoming renovation of all 678 bathrooms, replacing bathtubs with efficient showers, is expected to reduce water usage by up to 30% once complete in 2025.

Guests are also encouraged to participate through the Green Housekeeping program, which reduces the frequency of room cleaning, towel, and linen changes. In 2024, this initiative prevented the washing of 67,000 linen items, cutting both water and energy consumption dramatically.

Driving these results is a dedicated sustainability committee made up of representatives from every department. Their collaboration ensures that eco-initiatives are more than management directives; they're part of the hotel's culture. Suppliers, too, are expected to align with the same values, reinforcing a sustainable supply chain that magnifies impact.

### Redefining Meetings for a Greener Future

Beyond guest stays, the hotel's 30 conference and event rooms, spanning 1,800 square meters, are designed to host sustainable meetings and events for up to 1,100 guests. Each event automatically offsets its carbon footprint through the Radisson Meetings program, in partnership with First Climate, ensuring environmental responsibility without compromising service.

From the Sonja Henie Ballroom to the panoramic Top Meetings venue on the 33rd floor, every space integrates modern efficiency with environmental consideration. The hotel's use of the Hotel Carbon Measurement Initiative (HCMI) framework ensures transparency, accountability, and continuous improvement, setting a new standard for sustainable event management in Scandinavia.

### Community, Collaboration, and a Greener Tomorrow

While data defines the results, it is the people behind Radisson Blu Plaza Hotel, Oslo, who make sustainability meaningful. Their belief that "actions matter" permeates every part of the operation, from kitchen staff minimizing waste to executives driving systemic change. The hotel's Climate Contribution program, the first of its kind in both Norway and the Radisson Hotel Group, reflects a model of shared responsibility between business and guest, where every stay directly supports global green initiatives.

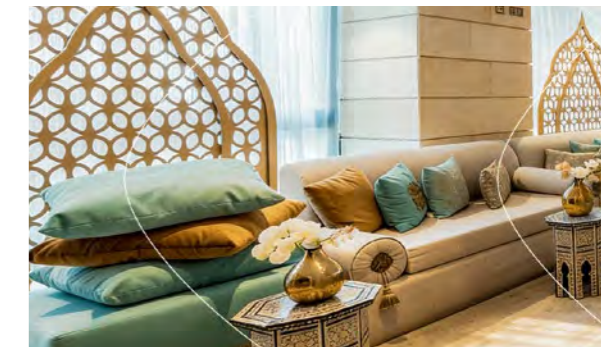

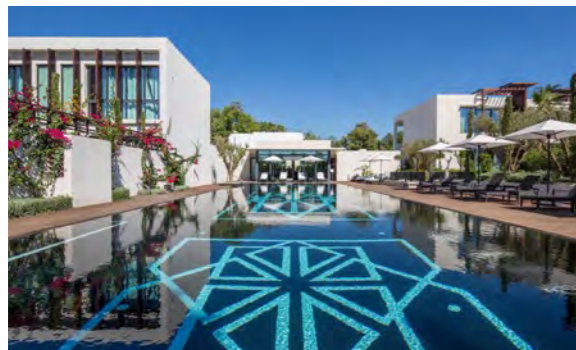

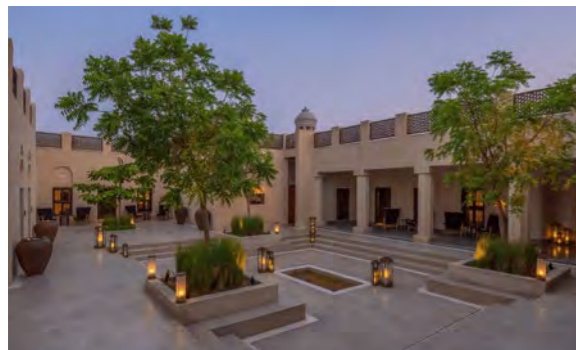

## NATURE-DRIVEN LUXURY AND RENEWAL AT VERGENOEGD LÖW THE WINE ESTATE

### Regeneration as a Way of Life

The estate's philosophy goes far beyond conventional sustainability. Rather than simply maintaining what exists, the team is working to restore and strengthen natural systems over time. Regenerative agriculture shapes the landscape, where vineyards, pastures, and natural habitats are managed as interconnected ecosystems. Nature-based enrichment supports soil health, and early monitoring is now underway to track changes in biodiversity and land resilience.

Livestock is integral to this approach. Indian Runner ducks move through the vineyards providing natural pest control. Dexter cattle and Dohne Merino sheep support rotational grazing that helps return organic matter to the soil and can reduce reliance on chemical intervention. These animals are functional contributors to a regenerative system designed to support soil vitality over time — and wines that reflect their place.



### Water, Energy, and Circular Thinking

Water stewardship sits at the core of the estate's environmental strategy. Greywater reclamation, dam-based water storage (fed by seasonal rainfall) and ongoing monitoring help the team manage irrigation efficiently and adapt to changing climatic conditions. Drought-tolerant landscaping complements the estate's broader water-saving approach.

Circular waste management helps close resource loops. Green waste from the gardens is composted on-site, returning nutrients directly to the soil. Kitchen waste is collected separately and repurposed as feed. Solar power provides an increasing share of the estate's energy, while continuous upgrades to insulation and energy-efficient systems keep consumption low.

This approach extends to daily guest operations, from biodegradable packaging to refillable amenities, empowering visitors to participate in a low-impact environment without compromising comfort.

### A Heritage Estate with Contemporary Purpose

With origins tracing back to 1696, Vergenoegd Löw remains one of South Africa's oldest working wine farms, a living national monument intertwined with the European Heritage Project and recognised as a WWF Conservation Champion site. Yet its future-focused environmental transformation began in 2015, when new leadership launched a complete revitalisation to align the property's legacy with a new ecological direction.

Today, guests experience this fusion of past and present through a spectrum of immersive activities. Guided nature walks, regenerative farming insights, and tasting experiences illuminate

how wildlife, heritage, wine, and sustainability intersect. The Art Walk, featuring works by celebrated artists including Dylan Lewis, further strengthens the connection between culture and landscape.

### Spaces for Restoration and Celebration

Vergenoegd Löw is also known for its atmosphere of quiet, expansive beauty — an ideal canvas for weddings, private gatherings, and memorable celebrations. Vast lawns, shifting light, and sweeping views create a setting that feels grounded in nature and history.

Its spa elevates the restorative experience with couple treatment rooms, revitalising therapies, and sensory rituals such as hydrating milk baths. Whether staying overnight or visiting for the day, guests are invited into an environment shaped by natural rhythm, calm, and thoughtful design.

The estate's dining offering continues to evolve as well. Two recently renovated restaurants, Geuwels and Clara's Barn, anchor a culinary philosophy shaped by Michelle Theron, the estate's first head of gastronomy. Produce from the farm and surrounding small-scale growers informs menus that pay homage to South African heritage while embracing modern techniques. Clara's Barn, the oldest building on the farm, retains its historic cobblestones and feeding troughs, celebrating its past while welcoming fresh culinary creativity.

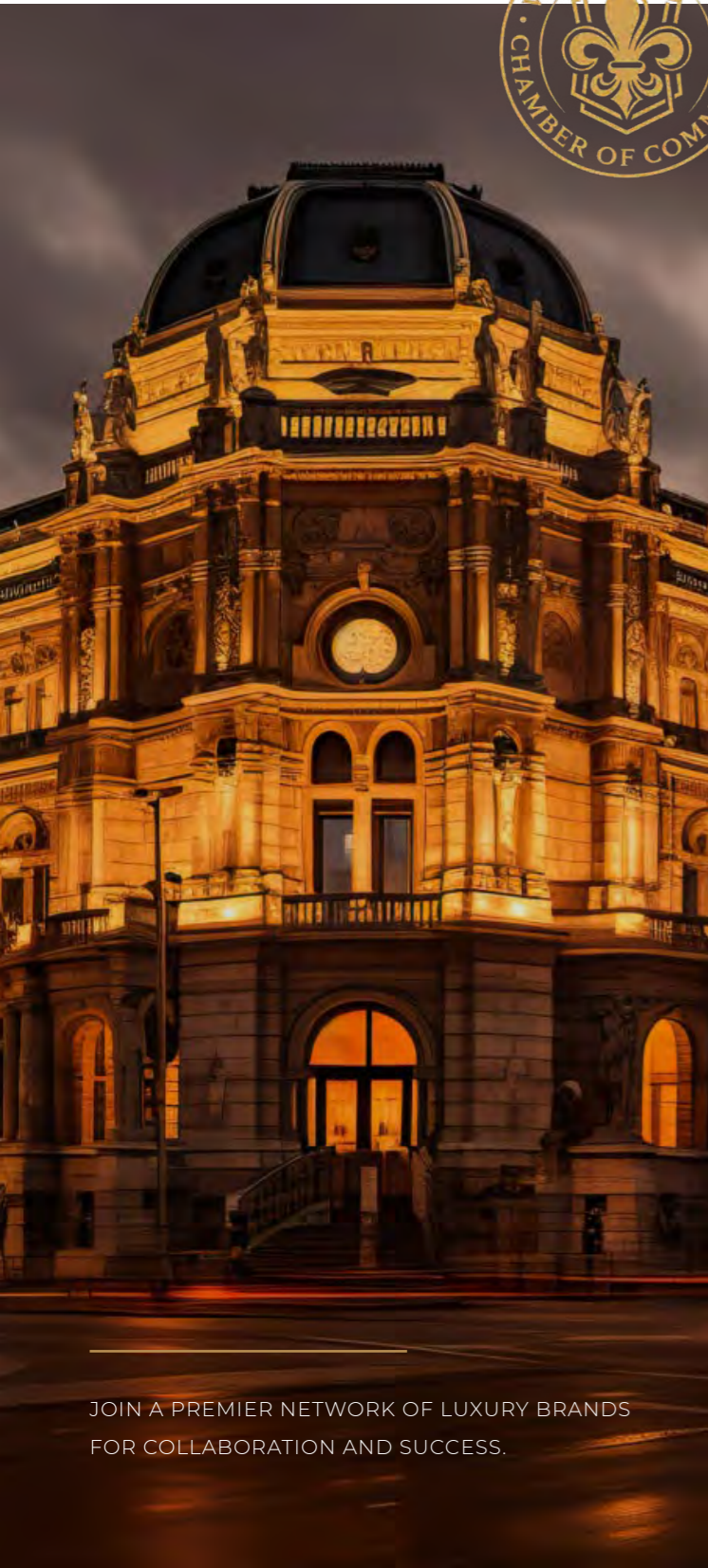
### Wine Rooted in Ecology and Expression
